We Outside...

A. Growing Torment (v. 22)

- **Blinding affliction (v. 22a)**
 - What is a hidden struggle or "blind spot" in your life that makes it hard to see God clearly right now?
- Who has been your One whom you have brought you to Jesus when you could not navigate the path yourself?

• Begging petition (v. 22b)

- When was a time you had to humble yourself and desperately cry out to Jesus for help?
- What makes it difficult for us to admit our need for healing to others in this group?

B. Challenging Assessment (vv.23–25)

• Private Escort (v. 23)

- How has Jesus ever pulled you away from the noise of the crowd to deal with your heart one-on-one?
- Why is personal, undistracted time with Jesus necessary when we feel stuck in our faith?

• Procedural involvement (v. 24)

- Why do you think Jesus healed this man in stages rather than all at once?
- How does the phrase "I see people, but they look like trees, walking" describe a messy or partial season of your own spiritual growth?

• Precise Improvement (v. 25)

- Where have you experienced a moment of clear, restored spiritual vision after a long period of confusion?
- How does seeing God's ongoing patience in this passage reassure you that "He's not done with me yet"?

C. Warning Christ (v. 26)

- Deployed Man (v. 26a)

- How does it feel to be sent back into your normal routine or home after an encounter with Jesus?
- In what ways has your perspective changed since Jesus touched your life?

- Demanded Mandate (v. 26b)

- Has Jesus ever placed a specific boundary or instruction in your life to protect your fresh spiritual sight?
- How can this group help one another obey Christ's promptings in our daily environments?

Help me to **know you** more deeply, to **follow** you more closely, and to **trust** the work you are still finishing in my life.

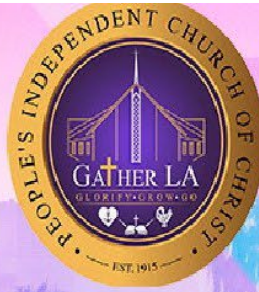

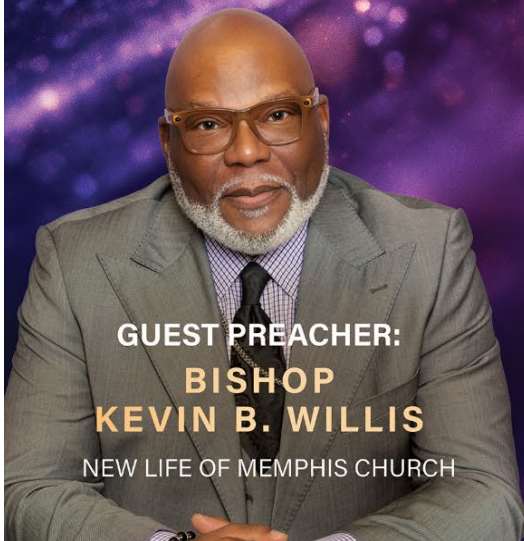
