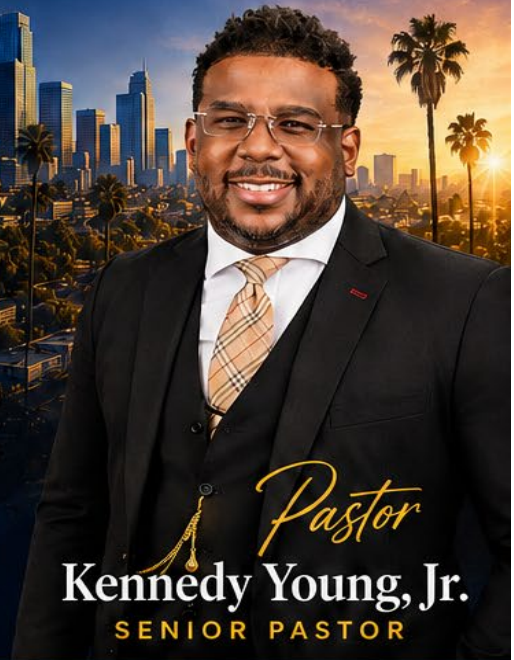

# Kennedy's Knotes

- A. Jesus' authority reinforces that the church is not an audience to be entertained; it is an army to be empowered.
- B. God did not come up with a mission for His church as much as He formed a church for His mission.
- C. Once you become a believer, the Great Commission becomes YOUR mission.

## Table talk...

### I. The Sovereign Kingship (v. 18)

Jesus claims all authority in heaven and on earth. This total power forms the base of our obedience.

### Absolute Acknowledgment

- When do you find it hardest to let Jesus be the absolute ruler of your daily choices?
