Theme Scripture: Mark 4:26-29

"If vision is the steak, then Culture is the plate. - It doesn't matter how good your steak is if it's served on a dirty plate!" - Pastor Joshua M. Daniels

Culture happens by design or default.

- In our homes, jobs, churches and business we can either carry the culture or kill the culture. We cannot do both and we cannot do either.
- Culture trumps everything.

What is Culture? Simply Put: It's How It All Feels!

We should seek to develop a life-giving culture!

If Jesus came to give life, our church should too!

Culture is ROOTED IN VISION

- Culture is either cultivated or tolerated. But one thing for sure, a healthy culture doesn't just happen!
- Healthy things grow.
- You cannot have a healthy culture without a clear vision.
- You cannot give life if you don't understand your assignment.
- Our vision is to CHANGE LIVES!
- Our culture must be rooted in this vision!
- We must begin to see ourselves as Life Changers. We must begin to see ourselves as carriers of the vision.

Culture is REINFORCED by VALUES

- To have a healthy culture you don't just need a clear vision, but you also need core values!
- Our Core Values represent who we are. They are not just what we do, they are part of our DNA. These are non-negotiable for our staff and servant leaders.
- Vocabulary matters. In order to get people unified around the same vision, they must first embrace the same values.
- Our vision tells us what we want to do. Our values tell us how we go about accomplishing that vision.
