Vision Made Plain

2. Experience Freedom

Think Process, Not Programs!

People naturally want to Make An Impact! But.....

- You can't Make An Impact until you know your role (Discover Purpose).
- You can't know your role until you settle your yesterday (Experience Freedom).
- You can't settle yesterday without a relationship with God (Love God).
- This is the process to deliver the vision.
- Now we're not focusing on programs, because programs don't move the vision forward. We focus on a process because the process helps us to move the vision forward.
- We have to love the vision more than our programs.

Benefits of Having a Clear Vision and Consistent Systems:

- Helps with Vision Internalization - Members will be able to clearly articulate what we are about.
- Helps with Vision Execution - We are able to set measurable goals that deliver the vision.
- Helps with Vision Communication - Our vision makes sense to members and the lost.
- Helps with Membership Retention - Once persons get into one part of our system, they will be encouraged into another and will become fully assimilated to the Church. - Closing the backdoor!

Take Home Truths:

- The quality of the product does not determine the success of an organization, but it is the delivery of the product that determines the success of an organization. - Example: McDonald's
- If you aren't fulfilling your vision, then you shouldn't exist!
- Growth is not optional as long as Heaven and Hell are realities! We can't just be faithful, we **MUST** be fruitful!
